**Subject: Comprehensive Plan Review Committee Progress** 

The purpose of this memo is to update the City Council regarding the status of the Comprehensive Plan Review Committee ("Committee").

#### **Background**

In November 2019, the City Council appointed a 16-member Comprehensive Plan Review Committee to diagnose and recommend necessary changes to the city's Comprehensive Plan (Plan) in four topic areas: future land use, transportation, housing density, and growth management. The Committee kicked off meetings on Saturday, January 11, 2020, and held a total of 27 meetings in 2020. Four planned meetings were cancelled due to COVID-19-related issues.

#### Status

Through December 2020, the Committee made significant progress reviewing and amending Plan policies in the four topic areas. These include revisions to 22 policy "bundles" (policy with associated actions) and creation of a new set of guiding principles. Although there are still minor revisions pending in three bundles, the majority of this policy work has received the necessary approvals by the Committee and the Planning & Zoning Commission (P&Z) to be ready for public outreach.

Remaining items under the Committee's consideration include the Future Land Use Map, a new Density Guidance Map replacing the Growth and Change Map, and two new policy bundles related to Plan Map Amendments and Growth & Redevelopment. Discussions on future land use began on September 1, 2020, and included a special work session on Saturday, September 19th. Although significant progress has been made since that time, substantial differences continue on key issues related to density and housing. No formal recommendation on these items has been approved at this time; however, the Committee did agree to send P&Z the latest draft materials.

### Tentative 2021 Schedule

The Committee may continue meeting in 2021 to complete recommendations on the Plan maps. To expedite the iterative process of sending recommendations back and forth between the CPRC and P&Z, joint CPRC/P&Z meetings may be used to approve a Draft Plan. However, based on the latest feedback,

it is now anticipated that agreement of CPRC may take through January, and perhaps even February, to finalize. Once a Draft Plan has received at least 75% approval by the CPRC and at least 50% approval by P&Z, it will be presented for public feedback.

Following the public outreach phase, the CPRC and P&Z will meet together to finalize official recommendations on a Joint Plan. The Joint Plan will be forwarded to City Council in accordance with the public hearing process required by state law and city ordinance. Agreement of CPRC has not been secured on all major issues; agreement of the P&Z is also required to move the process forward. It is uncertain if a plan can be presented to City Council by April or May of this year. The timeframe below includes preparation of agendas, packets, and related workload.

- Finalize CPRC recommendation to P&Z on maps and other outstanding items Unknown timeframe
- P&Z consideration of maps and other outstanding items; feedback to CPRC Likely 4-6 weeks
- Joint meetings to finalize mutual approval (if necessary) to create Draft Plan Unknown timeframe
- Public outreach and town hall meeting on Draft Plan Two weeks
- Joint meetings of CPRC and P&Z finalizing a Joint Plan, per public input Likely 3-4 weeks
- P&Z public hearing on Final Plan, as joint meeting with CPRC Two weeks
- City Council public hearing and consideration of Final Plan Three weeks

#### Public Outreach

After the Draft Plan has received the necessary approvals from the Committee and P&Z, it will be published online for public review and comment. Due to COVID-19 related challenges, typical in-person outreach meetings are not scheduled. An online survey will be posted on the Draft Plan website for approximately two weeks and a City of Plano Telephone Town Hall on the Draft Plan will be conducted. Advertising for the survey and town hall will be published through the typical City of Plano social media platforms, including Facebook, Twitter, and Nextdoor. Planning staff is also working with the Parks & Recreation Department to advertise the survey using yard signs strategically placed in city parks, and with the Neighborhood Services Department to promote the survey at BEST Break virtual neighborhood meetings.

#### Budget

Of the \$900,000 budget for consultant services, \$587,195 (65%) has been billed through November 2020. If costs remained steady, the current pace of expenditures would allow the process to extend through April 2021. This is sufficient funding to finalize a Joint Plan in accordance with the optimistic timeline above; however, the Committee is having challenges finding consensus on changes to the Plan maps related to housing density.

Additional funding of approximately \$50,000 per month will be necessary if the timeline extends beyond City Council adoption in April.

#### Questions for Council Direction

1. Is the City Council supportive of a timeline that includes a Plan reaching them for consideration in April 2021? If beyond April 2021, is there a specific time limit?

2. Will City Council authorize additional funding for meetings beyond the \$900,000 originally budgeted for consulting services, if necessary to complete the project? If so, how much?
