A Resolution of the City of Plano, Texas, authorizing the filing of an application for U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,407,268 under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act; designating the City Manager as Chief Executive Officer and authorized representative of the City for the purpose of giving required assurances, acting in connection with said application and providing required information; authorizing the City Manager to execute all necessary documents; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the City of Plano is eligible to receive Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) funds under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act, Public Law No.116-136) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in the amount of \$1,407,268, based on the fiscal year 2020 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) formula for entitlement communities; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest of the citizens of the City of Plano that application be made for such funding; and

WHEREAS, the summary of activities to be funded by CDBG-CV has been adopted by the City of Plano as a Substantial Amendment to 2019-2020 Action Plan via Resolution No. 2020-5-5.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION I. The City Manager, or his authorized designee, is hereby authorized to file an application for funds, consistent with the Substantial Amendment to the 2019-2020 Action Plan, under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), in an amount not to exceed \$1,407,268, on behalf of the City of Plano, Texas, and to certify to all understandings and assurances required under said Acts including, but not limited to, Title 2 CFR 200, the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and 1968, Executive Orders 11063 and 11246, and such other assurances and understandings as may be required.

SECTION II. The City Manager is hereby designated as the Chief Executive Officer and authorized representative of the City of Plano, Texas, for the purpose of acting in connection with the application and providing such additional information as may be required.

SECTION III. The City Manager, or his authorized designee, is hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents pursuant to this Resolution including any agreements between the City and HUD and any agreements to implement the Substantial Amendment to the 2019-2020 Action Plan.

<u>SECTION IV.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
