Effie Saifi, Justin Boatner, Deborah Herrington, Juan Villamizar, Meena Murti, Vahid Zakeri, Cory Feldman, Elizabeth Fruth, Nasrollah Jafarzadeh, Mina Saifi, Maryam Saifi, Ben Bhatti, Heather Miller, Arif Panju, Laurie Bornstein and Martha Tate spoke in support of the petition and proposed ordinance. John Stafford spoke in opposition. In addition to the speakers, 140 individuals registered an opinion of support of the petition and proposed ordinance.

The Council expressed concurrence to provide additional time for petition review.
