Mayor LaRosiliere called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m., Monday, April 26, 2021, in the Senator Florence Shapiro Council Chambers of the Plano Municipal Center, 1520 K Avenue and via videoconference. A quorum was present. Mayor LaRosiliere stated the Council would retire into Executive Session, in Training Room A, in compliance with Chapter 551, Government Code, Vernon's Texas Codes Annotated in order to discuss Economic Development matters, Section 551.087; consult with an attorney to receive Legal Advice, Section 551.071; and discuss Personnel matters, Section 551.074; for which a certified agenda will be kept in the office of the City Secretary for a period of two years as required.

Mayor LaRosiliere reconvened the meeting back into the Preliminary Open Meeting at 5:50 p.m.
