

An Ordinance of the City of Plano, Texas, ordering a Runoff Election to be held on June 5, 2021, for the purpose of electing one Member of Council to Place No. 4 to the City Council to hold office for a period of four years; and one Member of Council to Place No. 7 to the City Council until the May 2023 General Election; designating locations of polling places; ordering notices of election to be given as prescribed by law in connection with such election; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, a General Election was held on May 1, 2021, for the purpose of electing members of Council including Place No. 4; and

WHEREAS, a Special Election was held on May 1, 2021, for the purpose of electing a member of Council Place No. 7, unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, no one person received a majority of the votes cast at said elections for Place No. 4 and Place No. 7 on the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Justin Adcock and Kayci Prince individually received more votes than any other person for Place No. 4 and both are, therefore, entitled to have their names placed on a runoff election ballot; and

WHEREAS, Julie Holmer and Chris Robertson individually received more votes than any other person for Place No. 7 and both are, therefore, entitled to have their names placed on a runoff election ballot; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

Section I. A Runoff Election is hereby ordered to be held in and throughout the City of Plano on Saturday, June 5, 2021, for the purpose of electing the following members of the City Council of the City of Plano:

Member of Council, Place No. 4

The term of said place shall be for four years.

Member of Council, Place No. 7

The term of said place shall be until the May 2023 General Election.

Section II. The persons entitled to have their names placed upon the ballot at such election are:

Section IV. Votes for said election shall be cast by Collin County voters utilizing ExpressVote universal voting machines, ExpressTouch curbside voting machines, ADA compliant headphones and keypads, and DS200 ballot counters. Votes for said election shall be cast by Denton County voters utilizing the Hart InterCivic Verity Voting System.

Section V. Early voting by personal appearance for the above-designated election shall be conducted at the following locations on the following dates and times. The list of early voting polling locations for this election may be expanded subject to Collin/Denton County Election Administrators' decisions to include ballots at additional locations throughout the counties.
