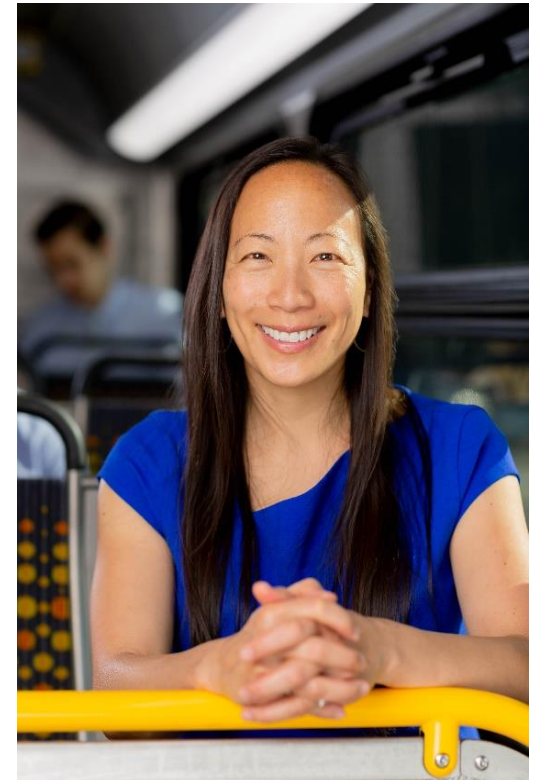

Announcement of New President & Chief Executive Officer

- On Tuesday, April 27, the DART Board of Directors announced the appointment of Nadine Lee as the new President & Chief Executive Officer. Nadine will assume her new position on July 12.
- Before joining DART, Lee served as Chief of Staff of the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro).
- Previously, she was the Deputy Chief Innovation officer in Metro's Office of Extraordinary Innovation where she led the development of Vision 2028, Metro's 10-year strategic plan to improve mobility and quality of life for Los Angeles County residents.



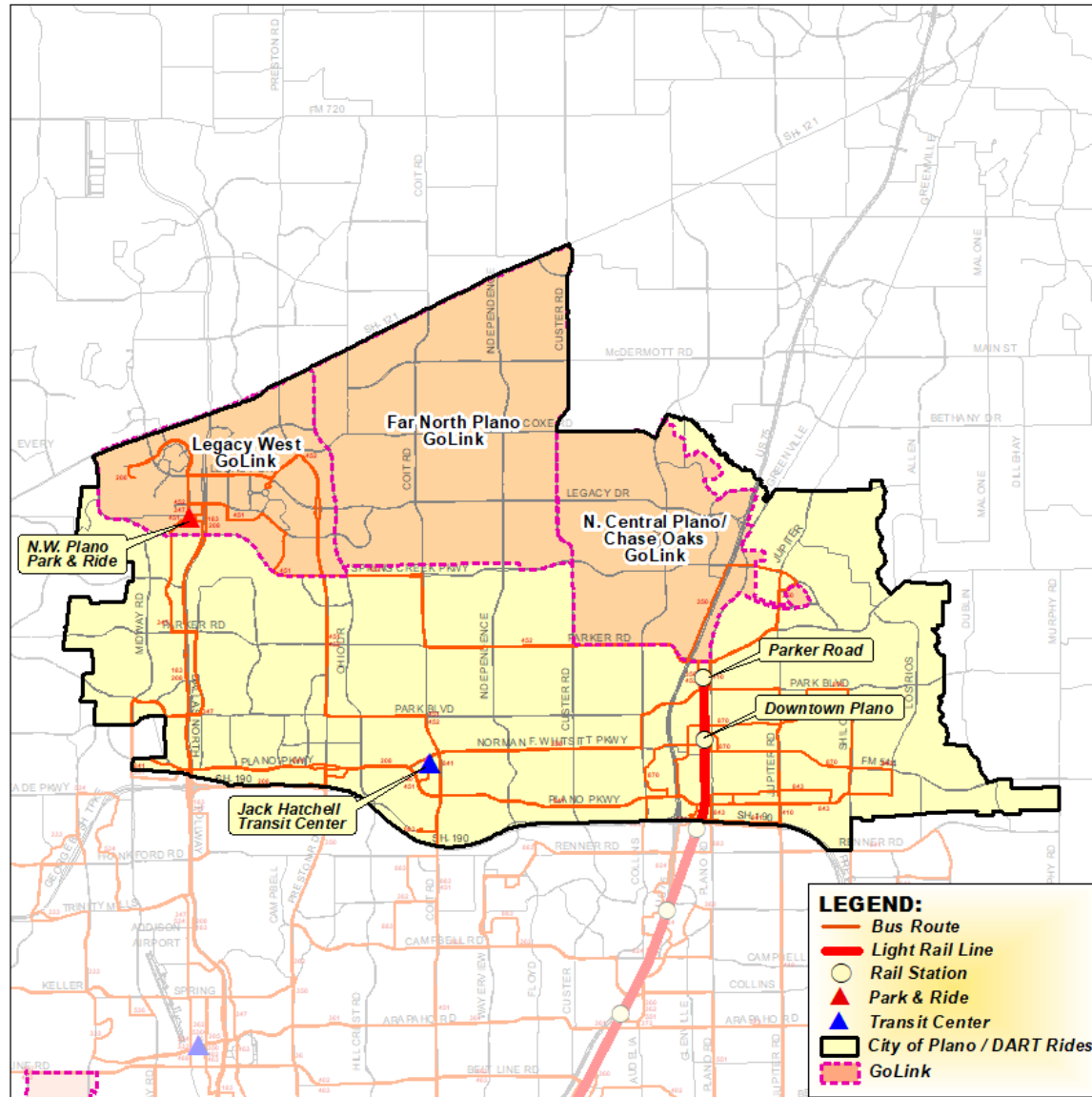
Announcement of New President & Chief Executive Officer

- Prior to her tenure at Metro, she led the development and implementation of the Flatiron Flyer Bus Rapid Transit for Denver's Regional Transportation District (RTD).
- Lee was appointed to the Leadership APTA Committee in 2019 and is a past director of the WTS International board. She was also honored as the WTS International Woman of the Year in 2019.
- She is a registered Professional Engineer in Colorado and Kansas, Lee received her B.S. in Civil Engineering from the University of Missouri-Columbia.

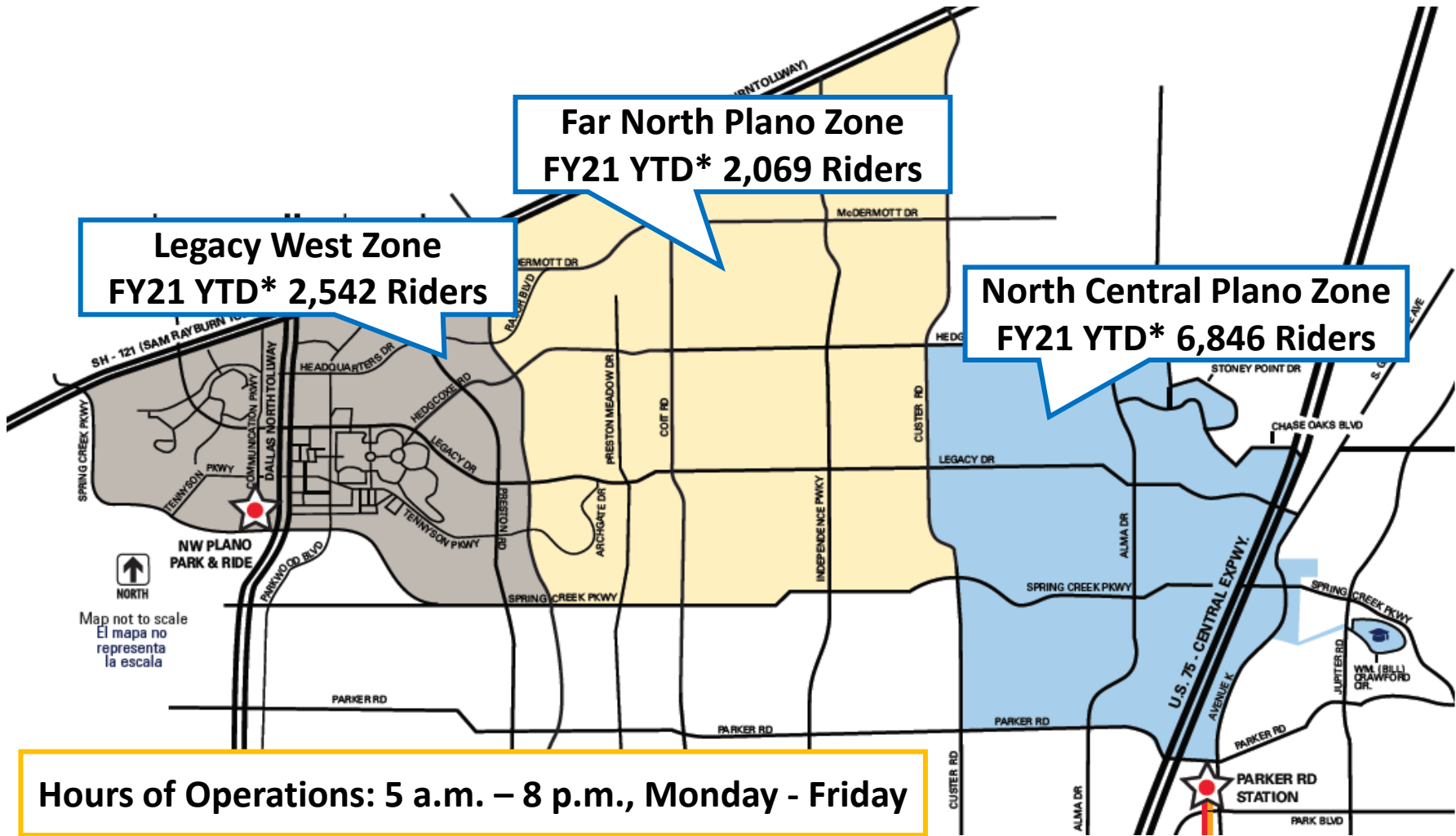

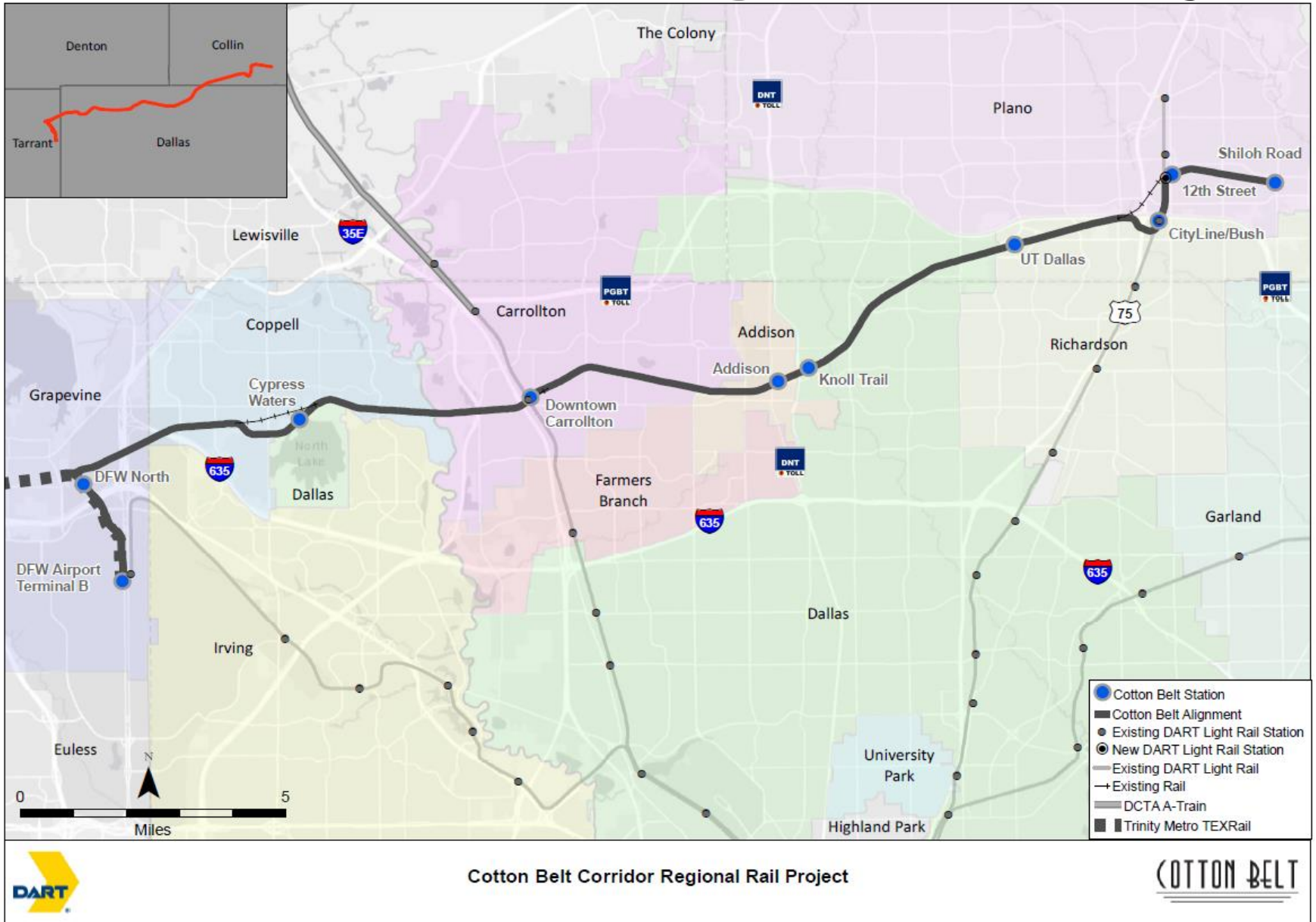

DARTzoom: A New Bus Network Update

Proposed Bus Network Plan

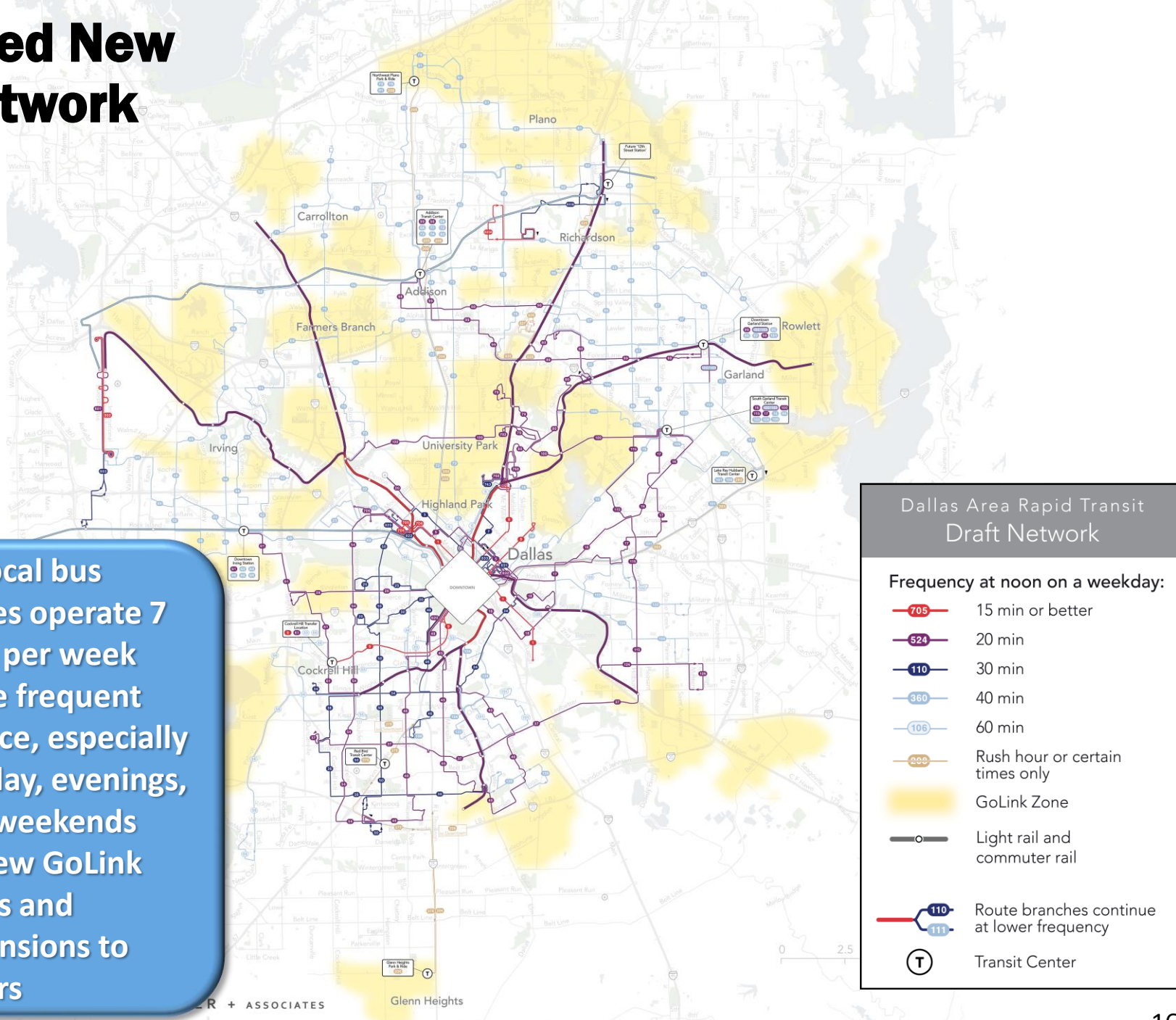
- DART has started public review of a Draft Final Bus Network Plan and associated January 2022 bus service change proposals
- This project is designed to improve service in the areas with the heaviest ridership potential, while providing GoLink coverage in areas where demand for service is lightest
- Fixed routes are more widely-spaced with a ridership-oriented design (some routes farther apart), and more routes offer frequent service with longer operating hours (including weekends)
- Many new GoLink zones are proposed to maintain service coverage; many zones will have weekend service

Key Plano Changes

- Greatly expanded service coverage via GoLink expansion:
 - 3 new GoLink zones in East, South Central, and Southeast Plano
 - Expanded coverage for the North Central Plano and Far North Plano zones
- More frequent midday and evening service on Plano bus routes
- 7-day service on all local bus routes throughout the service area, including local routes in Plano
- Saturday GoLink service for the first time in North Central Plano and Legacy zones
- Service to new 12th Street Station when it opens
- Collin Creek shuttle for new development (after January 2022)

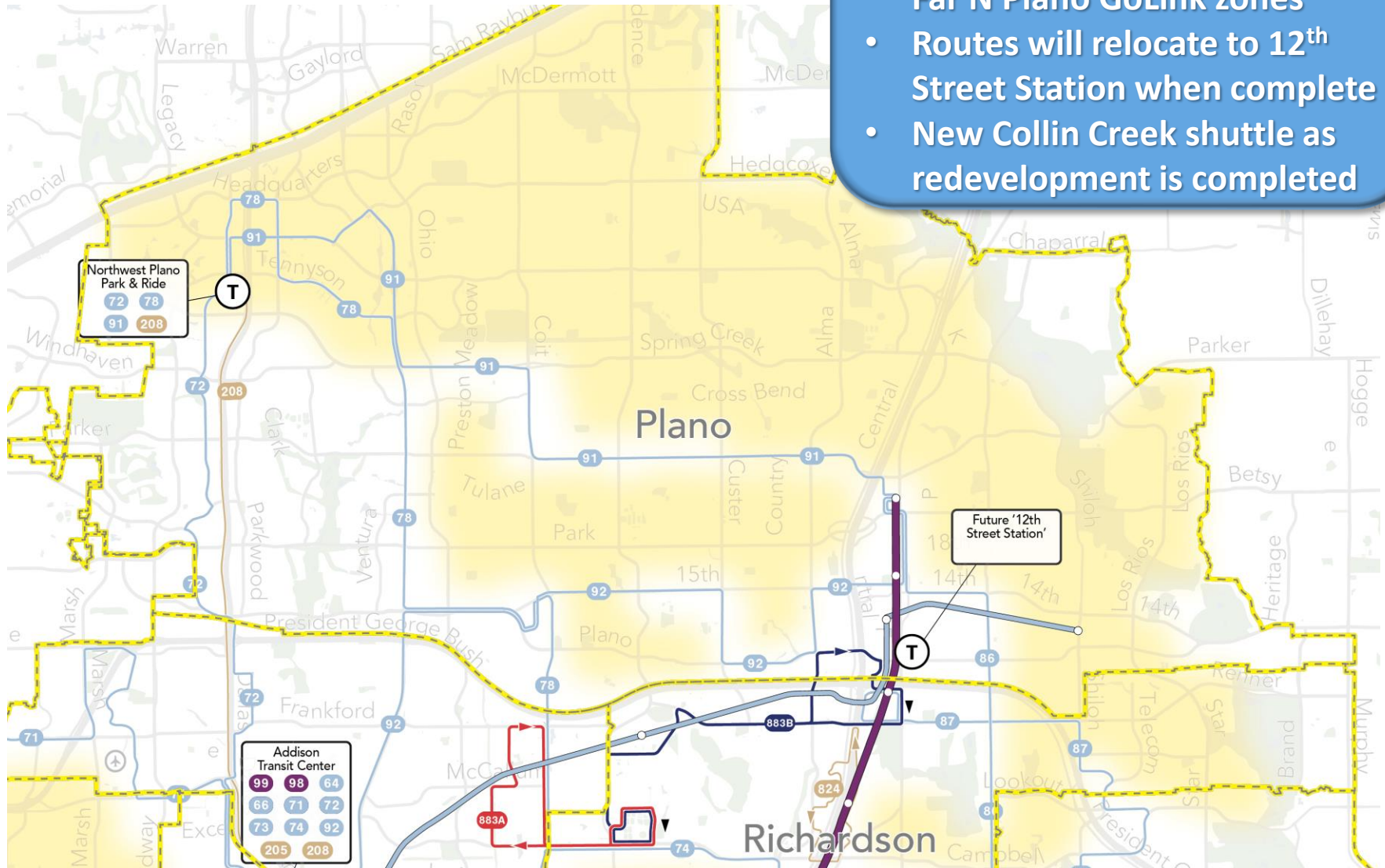
Proposed New Bus Network

- All local bus routes operate 7 days per week
- More frequent service, especially midday, evenings, and weekends
- 13 new GoLink zones and expansions to others



Proposed New Bus Network: Plano

- 3 new GoLink zones in East, SE, and S Central Plano
- Expanded N Central Plano and Far N Plano GoLink zones
- Routes will relocate to 12th Street Station when complete
- New Collin Creek shuttle as redevelopment is completed
