# PROPOSED SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO 2019-2020 ACTION PLAN

The City of Plano proposes a substantial amendment to its 2019-2020 Action Plan for the use of United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funds. The purpose of this amendment is to respond to the COVID-19 Pandemic by identifying activities for the use of CDBG-CV funding made available under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) (Public Law No.116-136). These funds will be used to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and respond to its impact through homeless housing assistance and homelessness prevention.
