

## BLAKE COLEMAN BACK-TO-BACK STANLEY CUP WINS

WHEREAS, Blake Coleman, National Hockey League (NHL) player, was born and raised in Plano and is the first Texan to win the Stanley Cup, not once, but back-to-back; he played for the Tampa Bay Lightning team that won its second Cup playing against the Montreal Canadiens; and

WHEREAS, he was a die-hard Dallas Stars fan while growing up in Plano, playing in the Stars Youth system on his way to becoming the first Plano raised hockey player in the NHL; and

WHEREAS, Blake scored two goals in the Cup finals, including a spectacular one-handed diving goal to tie the score with three-tenths of a second remaining in the second period of Game 2; and

WHEREAS, Blake scored 14 goals and 31 points in 55 games with the Lightning last season and played an important role in the team's Stanley Cup victories; and

WHEREAS, Blake was drafted by the New Jersey Devils in 2011, made his NHL Debut in 2016 with the team, and was traded to Tampa Bay last year; he is known to be a fierce competitor, a goal scorer, and an elite penalty-taker; he brings a physical presence to the game; and

WHEREAS, Blake became a free agent after this championship season and recently signed a six-year deal with the Calgary Flames;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN B.
