A Resolution of the City of Plano, Texas calling for a public hearing on the adoption of an ordinance to approve an Amended and Restated Final Project and Finance Plan for Tax Increment Financing Reinvestment Zone Number 4, being located within the corporate limits of the City of Plano; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, on January 13, 2020, the City Council of the City of Plano, Texas (the "City Council") established Tax Increment Financing Reinvestment Zone Number 4, City of Plano, Texas (the "Zone") by Ordinance No. 2020-1-10; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 311 of the Texas Tax Code, (the "Act") the Board of Directors of the Zone shall prepare and adopt a project plan and reinvestment zone financing plan for the Zone and submit the plans to City Council; and

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2021, City Council adopted the Tax Increment Financing Reinvestment Zone Number 4, City of Plano, Texas Final Project and Financing Plan (the "Plan"); and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2021, the Board of Directors of the Zone approved the Tax Increment Financing Reinvestment Zone Number 4, City of Plano, Texas Amended and Restated Final Project and Financing Plan (the "Amended Plan"); and

WHEREAS, Section 311.011(e), Texas Tax Code, provides that the City Council must give notice and hold a public hearing before amending a project plan and reinvestment zone financing plan if the project costs change, as they have in the Amended Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS:

Section I: That a public hearing is hereby called and is scheduled at or after 7:00 P.M. on September 13, 2021, in the Senator Florence Shapiro Council Chambers at Plano Municipal Center, 1520 K Avenue, Plano, Texas 75074, to receive public comment on the adoption of the Amended Plan.

Section II: That notice of said hearing, in the substantially final form set forth in Exhibit 1 attached hereto, with such changes as may be approved by the City's counsel, shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City before the 7th day prior to the hearing as required by the Act.

Section III: That all of the above recitals are hereby found to be true and correct factual determinations of the City and are hereby approved and incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein.

<u>Section IV:</u> That if any portion of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions hereof and the City Council hereby determines that it would have adopted this Resolution without the invalid provision.

Section V: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so resolved.
