It has come to the Court's attention that the Juvenile Curfew Ordinance is in the process of being reviewed to see if the ordinance should be renewed or allowed to expire. Such a review is required once every three years before the ordinance can be renewed.

The Plano Municipal Court believes that the Juvenile Curfew Ordinance is a valuable instrument in protecting the juveniles, citizens and property of Plano. The curfew ordinance has been helpful in identifying juveniles at risk and in referring those and other juveniles to programs that provide protection and guidance.

The Plano Municipal Court strongly supports the Juvenile Curfew Ordinance and urges the City Council to renew this ordinance.
