RE: Proposed Street Name Change

Dear Property Owner.

This letter relates to the east-west portion of Geomap Lane, along which our records indicate you own property in Plano, Texas.

The owner of the property to the south of this street has requested to change the name of this portion of the street to Love All Drive. Please find a map of the request enclosed. The north-south portion of Geomap Lane is not part of the request and will keep its name and, therefore, your address will remain 1100 Geomap Lane.

While Geomap Lane was originally platted in 1982, today, the City of Plano's current policy is to not have "L" shaped streets share the same street name. As such, we find the proposed name change to be appropriate in regards to public safety.

The City of Plano is proposing to prepare an Ordinance for consideration by City Council to officially rename the east-west portion of the street from Geomap Lane to Love All Drive. City Council is expected to hear this item at their January 24, 2022, City Council meeting.





Street Name Change Item Submitted:

Request to change a portion of Geomap Lane to Love All Drive Title:

Geomap Lane (Proposed to change to Love All Drive)

Surrounding Parcels





An Ordinance of the City of Plano, Texas, changing a portion of Geomap Lane, a dedicated street within the City of Plano, Collin County, Texas, to Love All Drive; providing for a change in the official records to reflect such action; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, Geomap Lane is a dedicated public street within the City of Plano; and

WHEREAS, the street name Geomap Lane was adopted by plat in 1982; and

WHEREAS, all of the property owners along a portion of Geomap Lane requested a name change for that portion of the street; and

WHEREAS, City staff have determined that the name of the street causes a safety risk because the street makes an angle similar to a right angle, yet retains the same street name both while going east-west and while going north-south, which is not characteristic of streets in Plano and can cause confusion and a lack of safety; and

WHEREAS, the street name change has been reviewed by the Planning Department, the Police Department, Fire-Rescue, and the Public Safety Communications Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, upon full consideration of the recommendation of city staff and all matters attendant and related thereto, is of the opinion and finds that the east-west portion of Geomap Lane should be changed to Love All Drive and that the official records of the city be amended to reflect this street name change.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

<u>Section I.</u> The east-west portion of Geomap Lane, a public street within the City of Plano, Collin County, Texas is hereby changed to Love All Drive. The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

Section II. This ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
