

A Resolution of the City of Plano, Texas, approving a contract with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development in an amount not to exceed \$1,988,051 in HOME Investment Partnerships Program – American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP); designating the City Manager as Chief Executive Officer and authorized representative of the City for the purpose of executing the contract consistent with this resolution, acting in connection with said contract, and providing required information; providing an effective date; and authorizing the City Manager to execute all necessary documents.

WHEREAS, the City of Plano (“City”) is eligible to receive U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) funds under the HOME Investment Partnerships Program - American Rescue Plan (“HOME-ARP”) in the amount of \$1,988,051; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into a contract with HUD in an amount not to exceed \$1,988,051 for eligible HOME-ARP activities including the production or preservation of affordable housing; tenant-based rental assistance; supportive services, including homeless prevention services and housing counseling; and the purchase or development of non-congregate shelter for individuals and families experiencing homelessness; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest of the citizens of the City of Plano that the City enter into a contract with HUD for such funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION I. The City Manager, or his authorized designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with HUD in the amount of up to \$1,988,051 in HOME-ARP funds, on behalf of the City, for the purpose of eligible HOME-ARP activities including the production or preservation of affordable housing; tenant-based rental assistance; supportive services, including homeless prevention services and housing counseling; and the purchase or development of non-congregate shelter for individuals and families experiencing homelessness.

SECTION II. The City Manager is hereby designated as the Chief Executive Officer and authorized representative of the City of Plano, Texas, for the purpose of acting in connection with the contract and providing such additional information as may be required by HUD.

SECTION III. The City Manager or his authorized designee is authorized to execute all necessary documents, including subrecipient agreements to implement the HOME-ARP funds and any additional contracts, including amendments, to accept additional funds from HUD.

SECTION IV. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
