

**A Resolution of the City of Plano, Texas, appointing Paul Francis McNulty as the Chief Judge of the Municipal Court of the City of Plano, Texas; setting the term of office and compensation for the Judge; and providing an effective date.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 4.04, Article 4, General Administration, of the Plano Home Rule Charter established the Municipal Court for the trial of misdemeanor offenses in the City of Plano, Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the presiding Chief Municipal Judge of the Plano Municipal Court, the Honorable Donald J. Stevenson, is retiring from his position effective June 3, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, Judge Stevenson’s current term expires on June 30, 2024 and his retirement will create a vacancy in the position of Chief Municipal Judge upon his departure; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 4.04(e) of the Plano Home Rule Charter addresses vacancies in office for the position of Chief Municipal Judge and provides that the City Council shall appoint a qualified replacement to fill the remainder of the unexpired term if a vacancy occurs.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS THAT:**

**Section I.** The City Council hereby appoints the following individual as the Chief Judge of the Municipal Court of the City of Plano, Texas and sets the compensation for the individual:

Paul Francis McNulty	Chief Municipal Judge	\$80.5857 per hour

**Section II.** The City Council hereby appoints the Chief Municipal Judge, Paul Francis McNulty, to serve the remainder of the unexpired term of the current Chief Municipal Judge. The term of the Chief Municipal Judge will expire on June 30, 2024.

**Section III.** The Chief Municipal Judge’s salary shall be considered by the City Council as part of his annual performance review. Future increases to compensation for the Chief Municipal Judge are permitted as long as those increases are consistent with any authorized changes to the city’s compensation plan as part of the annual budget process.

**Section IV.** This Resolution and the appointment shall become effective June 4, 2022.
