An Ordinance of the City of Plano, Texas, ratifying the appointments of the Chief Judge of the Plano Municipal Court of Record Paul Francis McNulty, and the Associate Judge of the Plano Municipal Court of Record Julie Pandya Dosher, and providing a publication clause, and an effective date.

WHEREAS, Section 4.04, Article 4, General Administration, of the Home Rule Charter for the City of Plano, Texas established the municipal court for the trial of misdemeanor offenses; and

WHEREAS, Section 13-3, Chapter 13, Municipal Court, Plano Code of Ordinances, provides for the selection and appointment of the judges of the Municipal Court of Record; and

WHEREAS, Section 30.00006, Chapter 30, Municipal Courts of Record, Texas Government Code, provides that the Municipal Court judges must be appointed by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Chief Judge of the Plano Municipal Court of Record Paul Francis McNulty was appointed by Resolution No. 2022-5-10(R) on May 23, 2022, and the Associate Judge of the Plano Municipal Court of Record Julie Pandya Dosher was appointed by Resolution No. 2021-8-1(R) on August 9, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it is in the best interest of the City of Plano to ratify the appointments of Chief Judge Paul Francis McNulty and Associate Judge Julie Pandya Dosher by ordinance to be consistent with state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

Section I. The City Council hereby ratifies the appointments of Paul Francis McNulty as Chief Judge of the Plano Municipal Court of Record and Julie Pandya Dosher as an Associate Judge of the Plano Municipal Court of Record and ratifies the compensation for the individuals:

Paul Francis McNulty	Chief Municipal Judge	\$80.58573 per hour
Julie Pandya Dosher	Associate Judge	\$52.884615 per hour

Section II. The term of Associate Judge Julie Pandya Dosher will expire on June 30, 2025. The term of Chief Judge Paul Francis McNulty will expire on June 30, 2024.

Section III. Future adjustments to compensation for Associate Judges are permitted for all Associate Judges as long as those adjustments are consistent with any authorized changes to the city's compensation plan including raises authorized as part of the annual budget process. The Chief Municipal Judge's salary shall be determined by the City Council as part of his annual performance review.

<u>Section IV.</u> Nothing in this Ordinance limits or otherwise prevents the City Council from revising the compensation of any individual at any time.

Section V. This Ordinance and the appointments shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.
