

A Resolution of the City of Plano, Texas, accepting the Certified Appraisal Roll for Fiscal Year 2022-23 for Collin County; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, under V.T.C.A. Tax Code Section 26.04(b), the Tax Assessor for the City is required to submit the Appraisal Roll for the unit showing the total appraised assessed and taxable values of all property and the total taxable value of the new property to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the certification of the 2022 Appraisal Roll by the Chief Appraiser, Central Appraisal District of Collin County, is attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and

WHEREAS, the calculation of the 2022 Collin County certified total value, including the value of new property is attached hereto as Exhibit "B," and

WHEREAS, upon review of the Certified Appraisal Roll of Collin County and all matters attendant and related thereto, the City Council finds that the Certified Appraisal Roll of Collin County for the Fiscal Year of 2022-23 should be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

Section I. The Certified Appraisal Roll for Collin County for the Fiscal Year 2022-23, as submitted by the City Tax Assessors/Collector, is hereby accepted.

Section II. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
