

**THIRD AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE
UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT DALLAS AND THE CITY OF PLANO FOR COLLABORATION
RESEARCH**

This Third Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement ("Amendment") is made as of November 17, 2022 ("Effective Date"), by and between **The City of Plano** ("Sponsor") and **The University of Texas at Dallas** ("UT Dallas"). Sponsor and UT Dallas shall be collectively referred to as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Interlocal Agreement effective May 1, 2019, First Amendment dated effective September 15, 2020 and Second Amendment dated effective September 8, 2021 (collectively, the "Agreement"), in which Sponsor desires to collaborate with UT Dallas in performing certain research.

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises herein contained and intending to be legally bound hereby, the parties hereby covenant and agree as follows:

1. **Section 2, subsection 2.2 of the Agreement** is hereby amended and restated in its entirety and shall hereafter be and read as follows:

The Research Program shall be performed during the period of May 1, 2019 through and including December 31, 2024 (the "Term"). The Parties may extend the Research Program under mutual agreement in writing between the parties.

2. **Section 3, subsection a) of the Agreement** is hereby amended as follows:

Sponsor will pay UT Dallas supplemental funds of \$11,004 for completion of the revisions to the Research Program pursuant to Amendment 3. UT Dallas will invoice Sponsor \$5,502 on January 31, 2023 and \$5,502 on January 31, 2024. The total amount of the Research Program is increased to \$86,004.

3. **Attachment A. Research Program** is hereby revised to include the following:
 - a. UT Dallas will Repair or Replace two main nodes that are currently not operational at Plano Facilities and Municipal Center. UT Dallas will provide parts and labor for the repairs at no additional cost to Sponsor, who will provide access to monitors. This work is to be completed by December 31, 2022.
 - b. UT Dallas will install one additional main node at the Environmental Education Center. Sponsor will provide and pay for a contractor to do the installation with the support of Sponsor Facilities and Technology Services departments. This work is to be completed by December 31, 2022.
 - c. Sponsor chooses to decline acceptance of 1 main node and 40 satellite nodes.

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED.
