

A Resolution of the City of Plano, Texas, reappointing Kimberly S. Moore, licensed attorney, to serve a two year term as ethics investigator as required by Section 2-104 of the Code of Conduct of the City of Plano; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 2-104 of the Code of Ordinances, the City Council shall appoint attorneys to serve as ethics investigators as required by the Code of Conduct of the City of Plano; and

WHEREAS, Kimberly S. Moore, licensed attorney, is currently serving as ethics investigator and has agreed to be reappointed for a two year period from February 8, 2023 to February 8, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that Kimberly S. Moore is qualified to serve as ethics investigator for code of conduct violations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS THAT:

Section I. Kimberly S. Moore is hereby reappointed by the City Council to serve as ethics investigator in determining violations of the Code of Conduct of the City of Plano. Her term is from February 8, 2023 to February 8, 2025.

Section II. This Resolution shall become effective immediately after its passage.
