

A Resolution of the City of Plano, Texas, providing the City Manager authority related to procurement decisions necessary for issues that arise due to supply chain issues; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, since COVID-19, the City has experienced supply chain issues related to purchasing goods that are a part of its normal operations; and

WHEREAS, City staff expects supply chain issues to continue, resulting in delays in receiving goods that are a part of the City's normal operations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is in the best interest of the City to authorize the City Manager to commit the City to purchases for budgeted and routine goods to avoid supply chain issues as set out herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

Section I. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to commit the City to purchases for budgeted and routine goods to avoid supply chain issues as necessary for ratification by the City Council at a later date as long as the procurement is in compliance with state law requirements.

Section II. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and shall terminate at the end of the day on February 29, 2024. The resolution may be extended by a majority vote of City Council.
