A Resolution of the City of Plano, Texas, approving the City of Plano Hazard Mitigation Action Plan and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, natural and human-caused hazards in the North Central Texas region historically have caused significant disasters with losses of life and property or damaging local resources; and

WHEREAS, the City of Plano has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the City of Plano Hazard Mitigation Action Plan (HMAP) dated June 2023, in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act as amended; and

WHEREAS, the City of Plano has conducted and documented hazard mitigation planning and community involvement in the planning process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Plano's HMAP is a record of the community's potential risks and hazards and outlining a communitywide commitment to reducing the long-term consequences of natural and human-caused hazards. The HMAP outlines mitigation goals, identifies risk reduction strategies for hazards that threaten the area, and discusses the ongoing risk reduction strategies to be undertaken within the jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has been presented a proposed Hazard Mitigation Action Plan (HMAP), a substantial copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the City Council demonstrates commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Hazard Mitigation Action Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS THAT:

<u>Section I.</u> The City of Plano's HMAP is approved in its entirety, including mitigation actions to be undertaken by the City of Plano. Substantial plan updates following the approval period for this Plan will require separate adoption resolutions for City Council approval. However, minor and non-substantive modifications to the Plan are authorized without a formal City Council resolution.

<u>Section II.</u> The City of Plano will continue to participate in the HMAP planning process, including reporting of progress as required by FEMA and the Texas Division of Emergency Management.

<u>Section III.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
