

An Ordinance of the City of Plano, Texas amending Section 12-13 (c), One-way streets on school days, of Article I, In General, Chapter 12, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Plano, Texas to amend or repeal one-way streets within the city limits of the City of Plano; and providing a penalty clause, a repealer clause, a severability clause, a savings clause, a publication clause, and an effective date.

WHEREAS, Jackson Drive by Jackson Elementary School, Mollimar Drive by Weatherford Elementary School, Silverstone Drive by Hughston Elementary School, and Wilson Drive by Shepard Elementary School are designated as one-way streets during certain times on school days to facilitate student drop-off and pick-up; and

WHEREAS, Plano Independent School District requested the removal of one-way restrictions for Jackson Drive and Wilson Drive that are no longer necessary and revisions of the effective times of one-way restrictions for Mollimar Drive and Silverstone Drive to reflect the new school hours that will take effect beginning in the 2023-2024 school year; and

WHEREAS, converting from one-way to two-way operation will restore accessibility in the community, and the proposed times for one-way operation will better align with the new drop-off and pick-up hours; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Engineering Division of the City of Plano recommends an amendment to a certain section of the Code of Ordinances to remove one-way restrictions for Jackson Drive and Wilson Drive and to revise the effective times of one-way restrictions for Mollimar Drive and Silverstone Drive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS THAT:

Section I. Subsection (c) of Section 12-13, One-way streets on school days, of Article I, In General, Chapter 12, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Plano, Texas is hereby amended to read as follows:

(c) The following named roadways are hereby designated as one-way streets on school days during the times and in the direction specified below:

<i>Mollimar Drive</i>	<i>From its intersection with the alley west of Independence Parkway to its intersection with Regal Road</i>	<i>Southerly</i>	<i>7:15 a.m. – 7:45 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. – 3:20 p.m.</i>
<i>Silverstone Drive</i>	<i>From its intersection with Fountain Head Drive to its intersection with Cross Bend Road</i>	<i>Southerly</i>	<i>7:15 a.m. – 7:45 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. – 3:20 p.m.</i>

Section II. All provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Plano, codified or uncoded, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, and all other provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Plano, codified or uncoded, not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section III. It is the intention of the City Council that this Ordinance, and every provision hereof, shall be considered severable, and the invalidity or unconstitutionality of any section,

clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other portion of this Ordinance.

Section IV. Any violation of any provision or term of this Ordinance shall be a Class C Misdemeanor offense. Any person, firm, corporation, or association who is adjudged guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor offense under this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$500.00) for each offense. Each and every violation shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense.

Section V. The repeal of any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance effectuated by the enactment of this Ordinance shall not be construed as abandoning any action now pending under or by virtue of such Ordinance or as discontinuing, abating, modifying, or altering any penalty accruing or to accrue, or as affecting any rights of the municipality under any section or provisions of any Ordinances at the time of passage of this Ordinance.

Section VI. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and publication as required by law and after all necessary signs and pavement markings have been removed or revised.
