PROPOSED SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO HOME-ARP ALLOCATION PLAN

The City of Plano proposes a substantial amendment to its HOME-ARP Allocation Plan for the use of United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) HOME Investment Partnerships American Rescue Plan funds. The purpose of this amendment is to prioritize homelessness prevention and tenant based rental assistance for the use of the funds, as well as clarify the four HUD designated, qualified populations eligible for assistance.

The Substantial Amendment to the Action Plan will be reviewed by City Council, and the public may comment at a public hearing during the Plano City Council Meeting on Monday, January 22, 2024, to be held at 7:00 p.m. The Council Meeting will be held in the Senator Florence Shapiro Council Chambers of the Plano Municipal Center, 1520 K Avenue, and via video conference. All persons wishing to speak to City Council are invited to participate in person or remotely via broadcast by webinar to voice their opinion (registration is required).
