

A Resolution of the City of Plano, Texas, authorizing a Substantial Amendment to the 2022-2023 HOME-American Rescue Program Allocation Plan for the use of U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development HOME Investment Partnerships American Rescue Plan Program funds; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires local governments seeking federal assistance through the HOME Investment Partnerships American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) Program to develop an allocation plan; and

WHEREAS, on January 9, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2023-1-5(R) approving activities and proposed use of funds set forth in the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan; and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2023, HUD Accepted the City of Plano 2022-2023 HOME-ARP Allocation Plan; and

WHEREAS, during the months of November and December 2023, city staff received HOME-ARP technical assistance from a HUD appointed consultant that has resulted in clarification being made to the existing 2022-2023 HOME-ARP Allocation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City's Citizen Participation Plan, which was submitted to and approved by HUD, requires a public participation process for substantial amendments when: (1) changes are made to the Consolidated Plan goals and objectives, (2) changes to project budgets approved in the annual Action Plan exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the project's approved budget, and (3) new activities are added to the approved annual Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Citizen Participation Plan, a public notice was published in the Plano Star Courier on January 7, 2024, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", informing the public of the proposed Substantial Amendment to the 2022-2023 HOME-ARP Allocation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on January 22, 2024 to receive public comments regarding the proposed amendment to the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION I. The City Council adopts the Substantial Amendment to the 2022-2023 HOME-ARP Allocation Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

SECTION II. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
