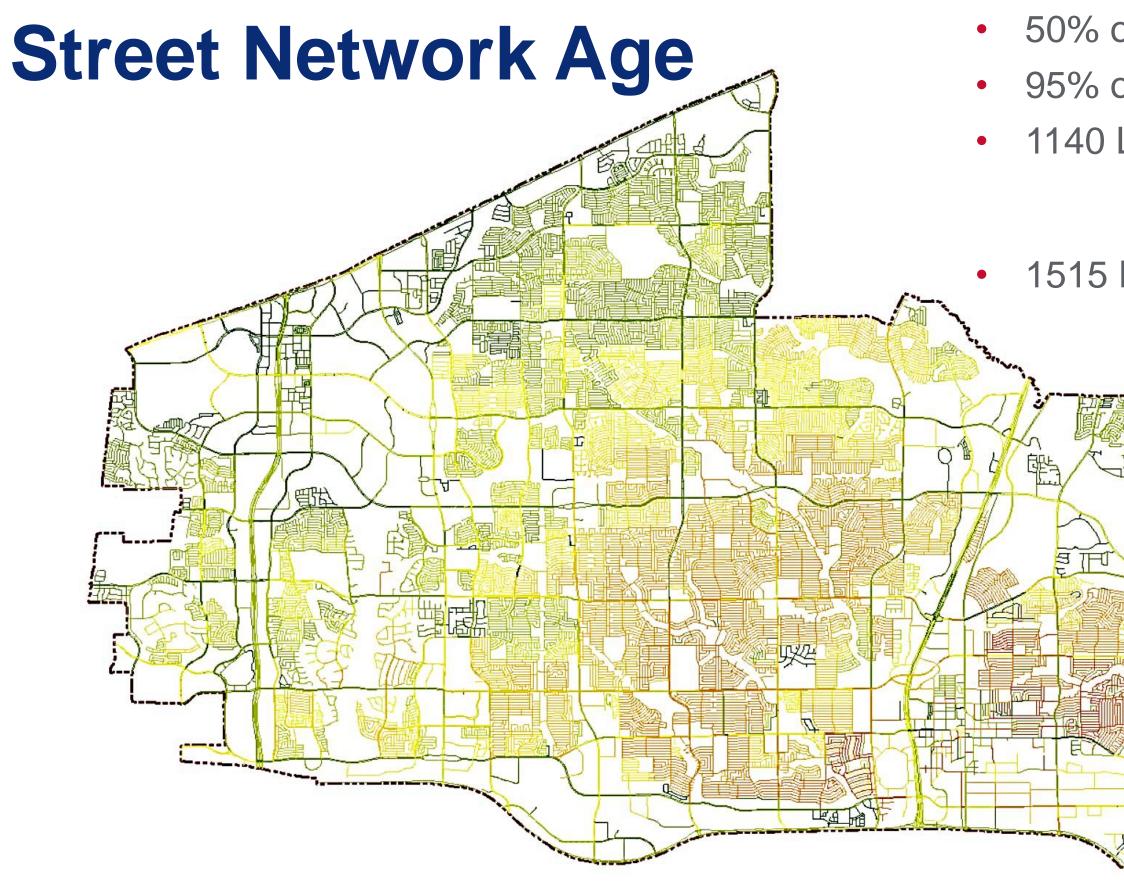

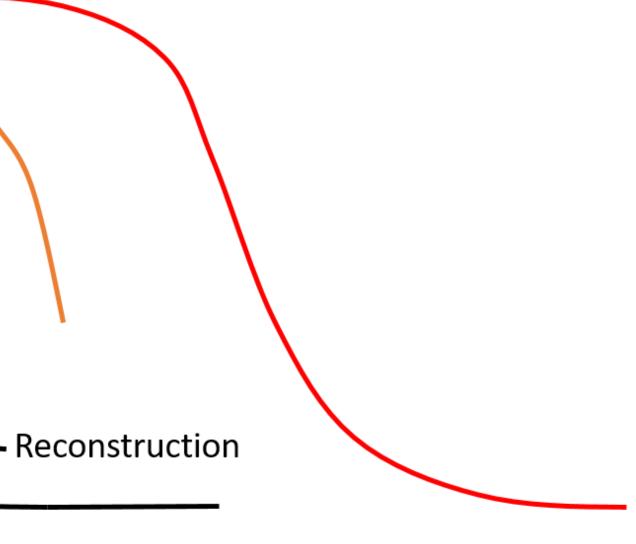

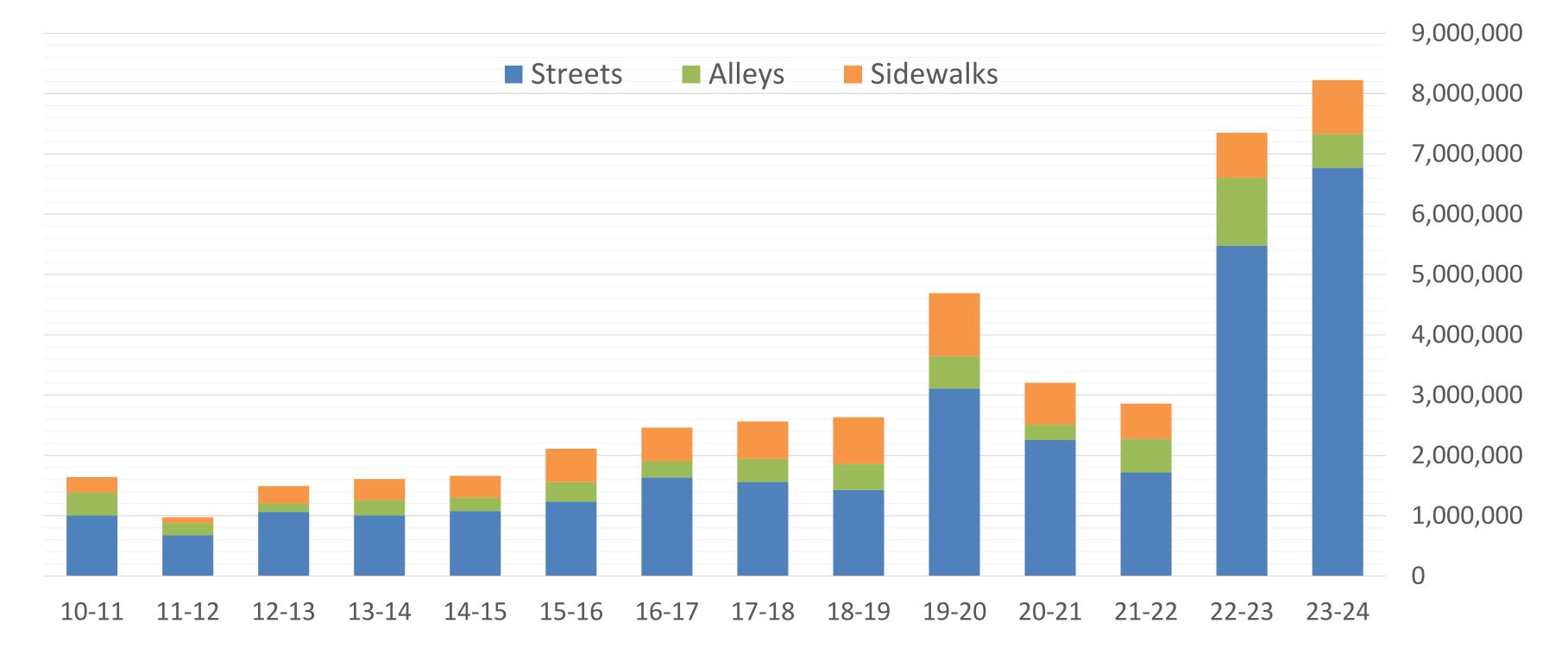

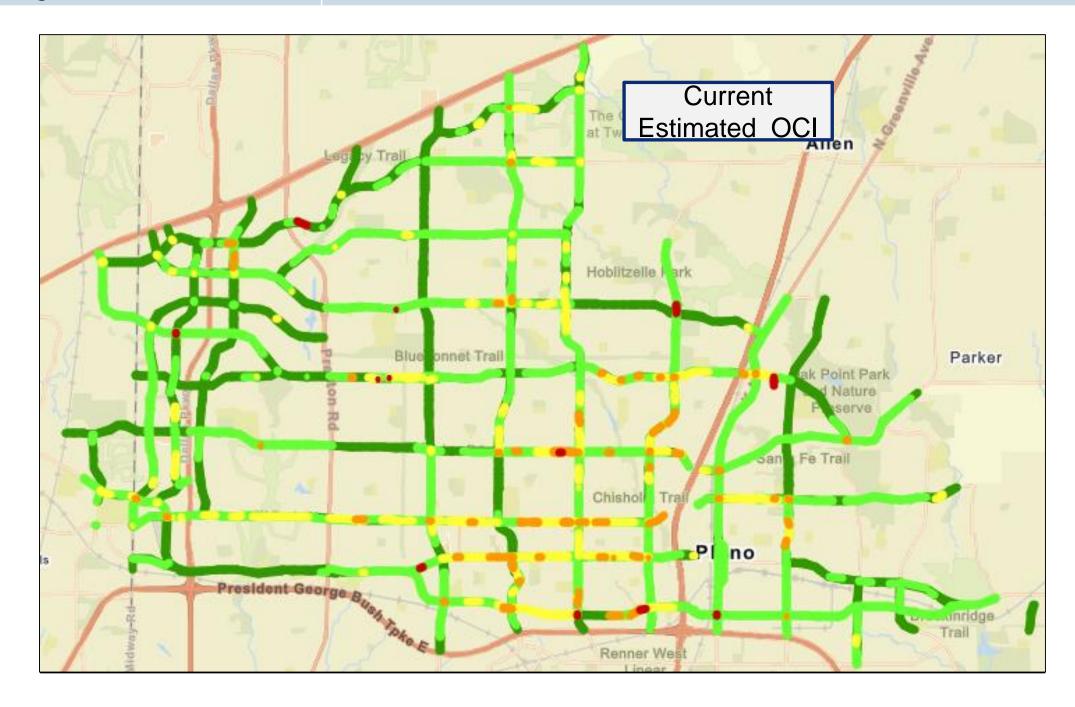




## Pavement Replaced (SF) per Fiscal Year by Public Works

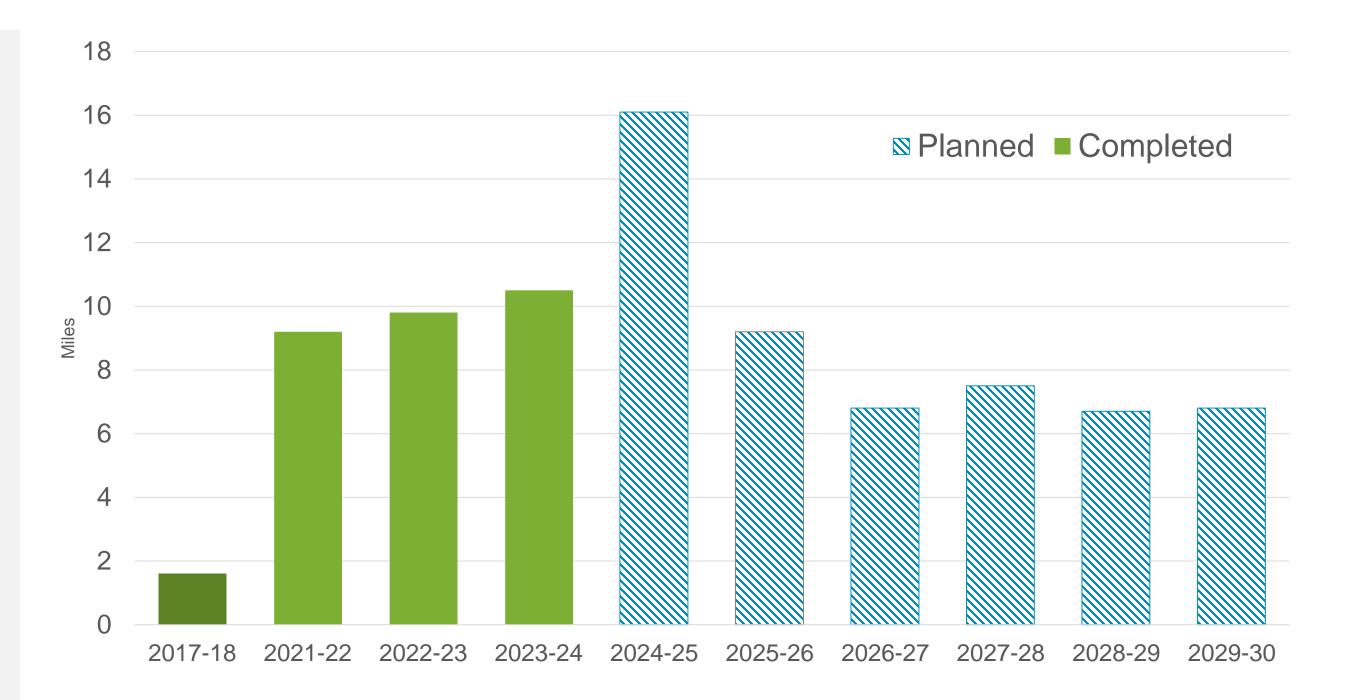

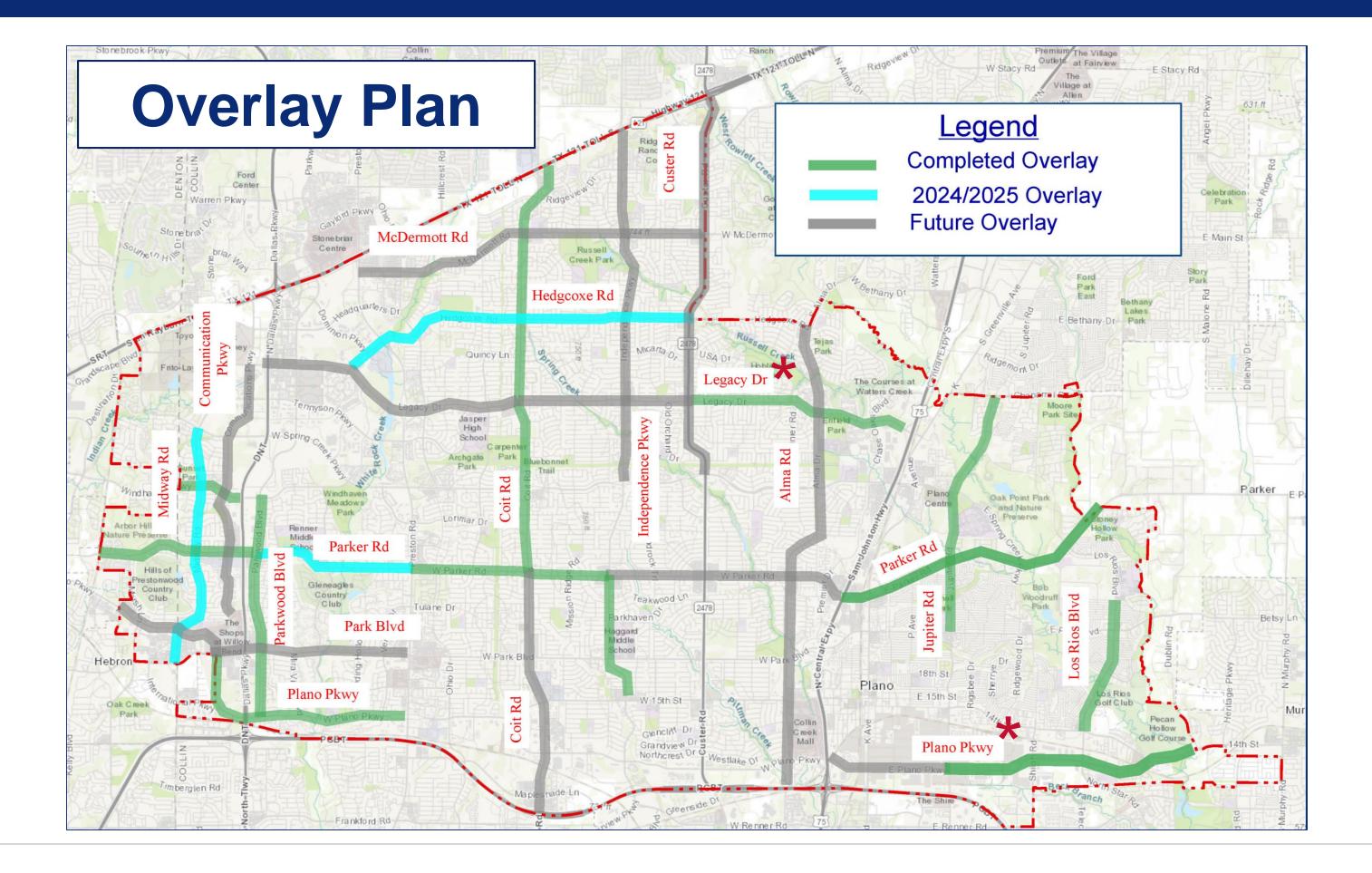

- 16.1 FY 24-25



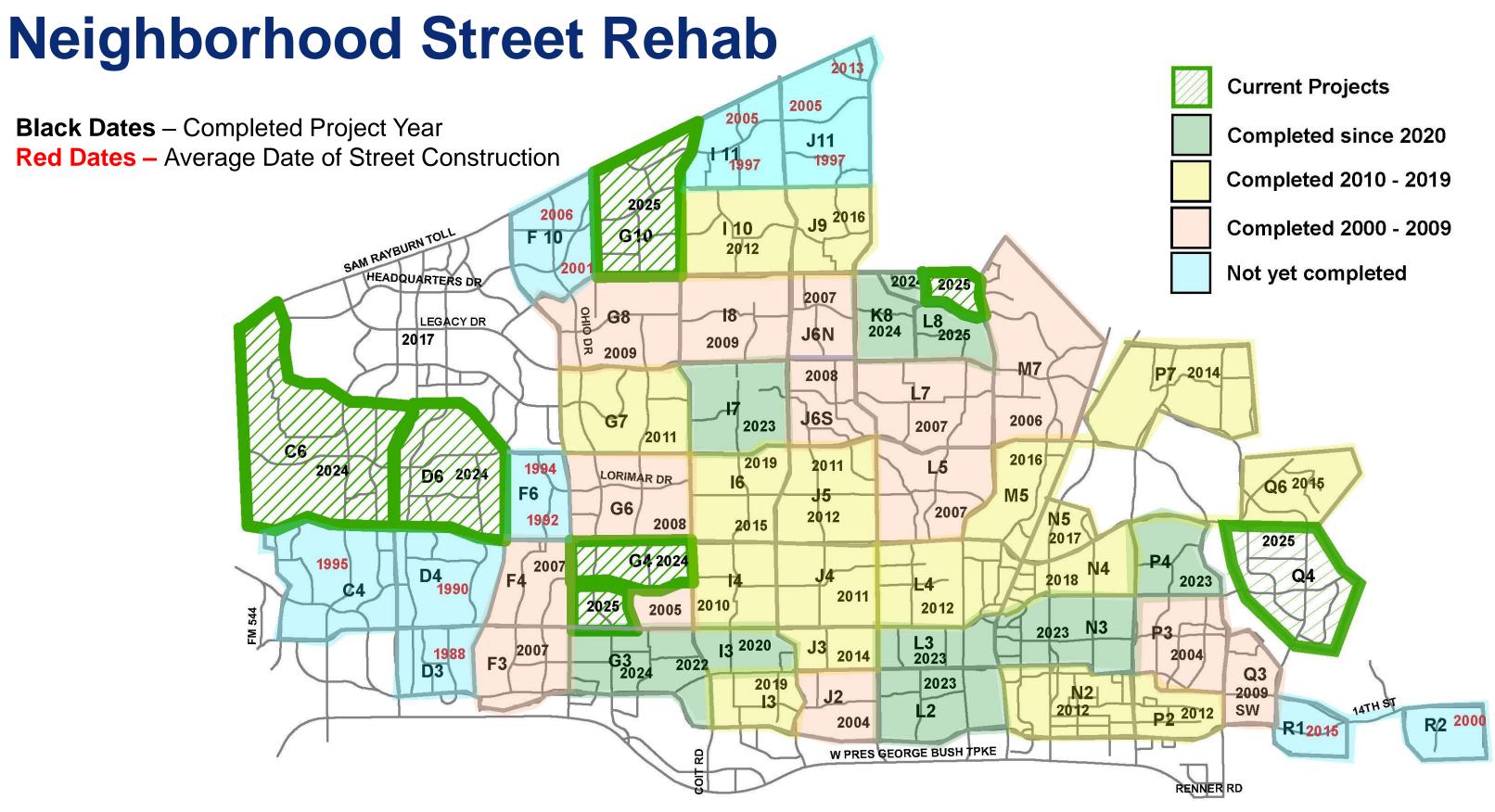




<b>Residential Street &amp; Alley Repair</b>

<b>Projected Cost</b>	\$92,750,000

- Maintenance of all streets & alleys in a neighborhood zone
- Repair major sidewalk issues and update ramps to meet ADA requirements
- Typical cost approximately \$5.3M per project
- Total amount in preliminary bond package is \$92.75 which covers approximate 8 zones in 4 years

Reconstruction of deteriorated concrete alleys or construction of new alleys in existing residential areas. Funding will be transferred to specific projects as they are identified.

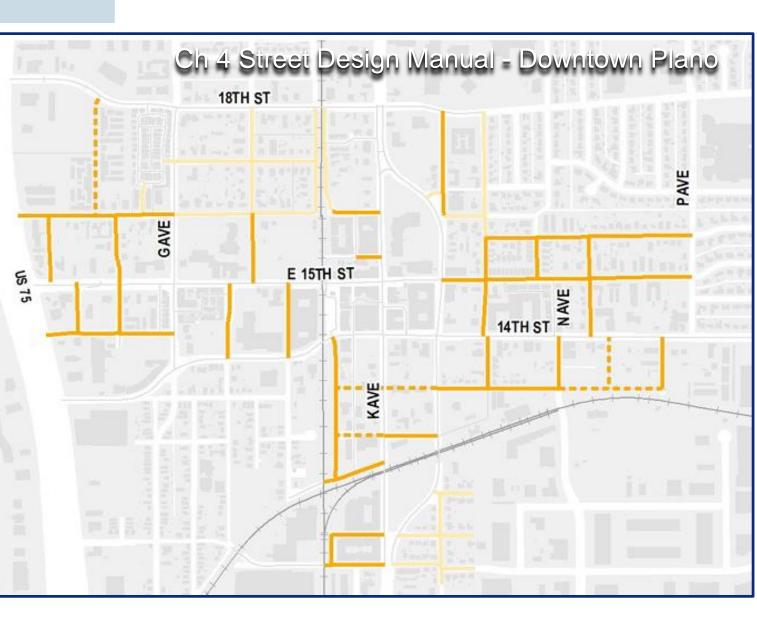
