Mayor Muns called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m., Monday, May 12, 2025, in the Senator Florence Shapiro Council Chambers of the Plano Municipal Center, 1520 K Avenue and via videoconference. A quorum was present.

Resolution No. 2025-5-1(R): To canvass the returns and declaring the results of the bond election held May 3, 2025 and resolving other matters incident and related thereto. (Canvass Item "I")

Upon a motion made by Councilmember Horne and seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Tu, the Council voted 8-0 to declare the election returns of the Bond Election as canvassed and all votes accounted for as certified by the Elections Administrator of Collin County, with a total of 20,593 ballots cast, and further made a motion to adopt a resolution to approve the canvass of the election results of the bond election held May 3, 2025 and resolving other matters incident and related thereto; and further to adopt Resolution No. 2025-5-1(R).

Resolution No. 2025-5-2(R): To canvass the election returns of the Special Election of May 3, 2025, for the election of member of Council Place 5, for an unexpired term until the May 2027 General Election; declaring the results; and resolving other matters on the subject. (Canvass Item "II")

Upon a motion made by Mayor Pro Tem Tu and seconded by Councilmember Horne, the Council voted 8-0 to declare the election returns of the Special Election as canvassed and all votes accounted for as certified by the Elections Administrator of Collin County, with a total of 20,593 ballots cast and further made a motion to adopt a resolution to approve the canvass of the election returns of the Special Election of May 3, 2025, for the election of member of Council Place 5, for an unexpired term until the May 2027 General Election; declaring Steve Lavine elected to Place 5; and resolving other matters on the subject; and further to adopt Resolution No. 2025-5-2(R).

Resolution No. 2025-5-3(R): To canvass the election returns of the General Election of May 3, 2025, for the election of four members of Council [Places 2, 4, 6 (Mayor) and 8] for a term of four years; declaring the results; and resolving other matters on the subject. (Canvass Item “III”)

Upon a motion made by Councilmember Horne and seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Tu, the Council voted 8-0 to declare the election returns of the General Election as canvassed and all votes accounted for as certified by the Elections Administrator of Collin County, with a total of 20,593 ballots cast and further made a motion to adopt a resolution to approve the canvass of the election returns of the General Election of May 3, 2025, for the election of four members of Council [Places 2, 4, 6 (Mayor) and 8] for a term of four years; declaring Bob Kehr was elected to Place 2, Chris Krupa Downs was elected to Place 4, John Muns was elected to Place 6 (Mayor) and Vidal Quintanilla Jr. to Place 8; and resolving other matters on the subject; and further to adopt Resolution No. 2025-5-3(R).
