<p>¹<i>Food Establishment Type I – IV refers to the risk categorization and resulting inspection frequencies of food establishments as defined in the FDA’s Voluntary National Retail Food Regulatory Program Standards. Definitions below.</i></p> <p>Retail Food Store Type I: Establishment that serves and/or sells prepackaged Time/Temperature Control for Safety (TCS) and non-TCS food items. Establishment does not engage in portioning activities including, but not limited to, meat market, bakery, and deli operations.</p> <p>Retail Food Store Type II: Establishment that serves and/or sells prepackaged and non-prepackaged TCS and non-TCS food items. Establishment engages in portioning activities including but not limited to meat market; bakery; and deli operations. No cooking or hot holding of TCS or non-TCS food is done onsite.</p> <p>Retail Food Store Type III: Establishment that serves and/or sells prepackaged and non-prepackaged TCS and non-TCS food items. Establishment engages in portioning activities including but not limited to meat market; bakery; and deli operations. Establishments that have an extensive menu and handling of raw ingredients. Complex preparation including cooking, cooling, and reheating for hot holding involves many TCS foods. Variety of processes require hot and cold holding of TCS food.</p> <p>Food Establishment Type I: Establishment that serves or sells only pre-packaged, non-TCS foods. Establishments that prepare only non-TCS foods. Establishments that heat only commercially processed TCS foods for hot holding. No cooling of TCS foods. Establishments that would otherwise be grouped in Category 2 but have shown through historical documentation to have achieved active managerial control of foodborne illness risk factors.</p> <p>Food Establishment Type II: Establishments that serve mostly products that are prepared/cooked and served immediately. May involve hot and cold holding of TCS foods after preparation or cooking. Complex preparation of TCS foods requiring cooking, cooling, and reheating for hot holding is limited to a few TCS foods. Establishments that would otherwise be grouped in Category 3 but have shown through historical documentation to have achieved active managerial control of foodborne illness risk factors. Newly permitted establishments that would otherwise be grouped in Category 1 until history of active managerial control of foodborne illness risk factors is achieved and documented.</p> <p>Food Establishment Type III: Establishments that have an extensive menu and handling of raw ingredients. Complex preparation including cooking, cooling, and reheating for hot holding involves many TCS foods. Variety of processes require hot and cold holding of TCS food. Establishments that would otherwise be grouped in Category 4 but have shown through historical documentation to have achieved active managerial control of foodborne illness risk factors. Newly permitted establishments that would otherwise be grouped in Category 2 until history of active managerial control of foodborne illness risk factors is achieved and documented.</p> <p>Food Establishment Type IV: Establishments serving a highly susceptible population or that conduct specialized processes (e.g. smoking and curing, reduced oxygen packaging for extended shelf-life).</p> <p>²<i>No permit shall be issued or renewed until the applicable permit fee is paid. Late fees for permit renewals shall apply as indicated.</i></p> <p>³<i>A plan review fee shall be charged for the review of plans and specifications of new construction.</i></p> <p>⁴<i>A remodel or expansion review applies only to those establishments currently permitted by the Environmental Health Division. All other construction is considered "new construction" and must pay the regular plan review fee.</i></p> <p>⁵<i>For re-inspections required due to critical violation issues or other required compliance inspection</i></p> <p>⁶<i>Deposit of 50% due at booking with remainder due at contract signing. Reservations cancelled with at least 14 days’ notice from the rental date will be refunded minus a 10% administrative fee. Reservations cancelled with less than 14 days’ notice from the rental date will not be refunded.</i></p> <p>⁷<i>Proof of charitable non-profit status [501(c)(3)] must be submitted with application.</i></p> <p>⁸<i>Adopt a Highway Partners pay a one-time registration fee for cost of fabricating/installing two signs recognizing adopting organization.</i></p>
