

A Resolution of the City of Plano, Texas, suspending the September 17, 2025 effective date of the proposal by CoServ Gas, Ltd. to implement interim GRIP rate adjustments for gas utility investment in 2024; requiring delivery of this Resolution to the Company and legal counsel; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the City of Plano, Texas ("City") is a gas utility customer of CoServ Gas, Ltd., ("CoServ" or "the Company") and a regulatory authority with an interest in the rates and charges of CoServ; and

WHEREAS, CoServ made filings with the City and the Railroad Commission of Texas ("Railroad Commission") on July 18, 2025, proposing to implement interim rate adjustments ("GRIP Rate Increases") pursuant to Texas Utilities Code § 104.301 on all customers served by CoServ, effective September 17, 2025; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the City, as a regulatory authority, to examine the GRIP Rate Increases to determine its compliance with the Texas Utilities Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

Section I. The September 17, 2025 effective date of the GRIP Rate Increases proposed by CoServ is hereby suspended for the maximum period allowed by Texas Utilities Code § 104.301(a).

Section II. A copy of this Resolution shall be sent to CoServ, care of Brent Bishop at 7701 South Stemmons Freeway, Corinth, Texas 76210, and to Thomas Brocato, legal counsel to the City, at Lloyd Gosselink, 816 Congress Ave., Suite 1900, Austin, Texas 78701.

Section III. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
