Fee Detail

- 1. <u>Certificate of Occupancy</u> C.O. procedure has evolved to include reviews by Building Inspections and Planning. The fee has been adjusted to reflect BI costs to meet 68% recovery in three years.
- Clean and Show/House Lights electrical power inspection for lease space w/o tenant or a new owner for a shopping center needing to setup an electrical account
- 3. Contractor Solid Waste Disposal align registration fee same as all contractor registration fees
- 4. In-Home Day Care permit and inspections for child day care in residential home
- 5. Mobile home gas/elec hookup \$50 move to \$65
- 6. Outdoor fireplace \$50 move to \$75
- 7. <u>Simple Trade Permits</u> A residential permit which has been at \$65 for several years needing adjustment for recovery at \$85.
- 8. <u>Reinspection Fee First Reinspection</u> A fee charged to contractors where no corrective action occurs in the field when a previous inspection list has already been delivered.
- 9. <u>Reinspection Fee Second Reinspection</u> An elevated fee charged to contractors where again no corrective actions have occurred when a previous inspection list has already been delivered.
- 10. <u>Reinspection Fee- Third Reinspection</u> A third time elevated fee charged to contractors with repeated inactions have occurred when a previous inspection list has already been delivered.
- 11. After Hours Inspections Any inspections requested after 5 pm
- 12. Same Day Inspections A service offered for contractors needing an inspection on the same day.
- 13. Temporary Seasonal sales captured under Itinerant Vendor permits adjusted from \$100 to \$120
- 14. <u>Plumbing Site Pre Build</u> Plumbing inspections for new water and sewer service connections from the main city lines to new buildings.

Fees Removed

- 1. Awning Commercial \$75 fee which we capture with a separate permit for construction or when a sign permit is issued with an awning
- 2. Satellite Dish \$75 fee we no longer see as these types of large satellite dishes are not being used.
- 3. Reprint of lost permit Contractors are responsible for making copies of permits when issued.
