**Subject:** **Traffic Signal and Miscellaneous Traffic Construction  
(City of Plano Contract 2019-0596-I)**

The Public Works staff recommends participating on the City of McKinney contract 18-48FP for the Traffic Signal and Miscellaneous Traffic Construction with Bean Electrical Inc. and Durable Specialties, Inc. to install Traffic Signal equipment on an as needed basis. Of the Cooperative Contracts reviewed, the City of McKinney's contract is more thorough which is better suited for the City's needs. The original contract is for a two (2) year period ending on September 17, 2020 and shall be automatically renewed annually for an additional three (3) one-year terms. The estimated annual expenditure is \$675,000.

If this contract is not awarded by City Council, new intersections will not be built, and repairs to existing intersections will not be completed causing dangerous public safety issues for drivers traveling throughout the City.

The funding for this project is coming from the Capital Maintenance Fund – Signalization Upgrade (35-51149).
