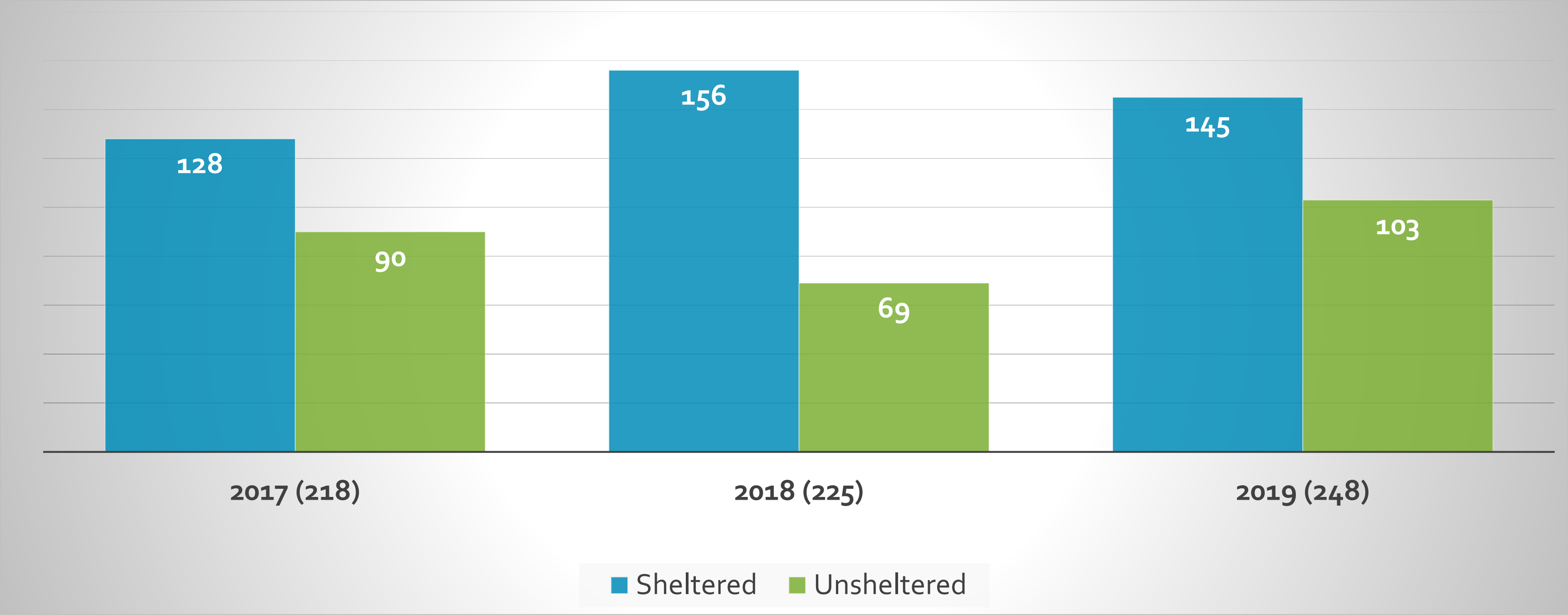

# Three Year Perspective: Plano Homeless Population

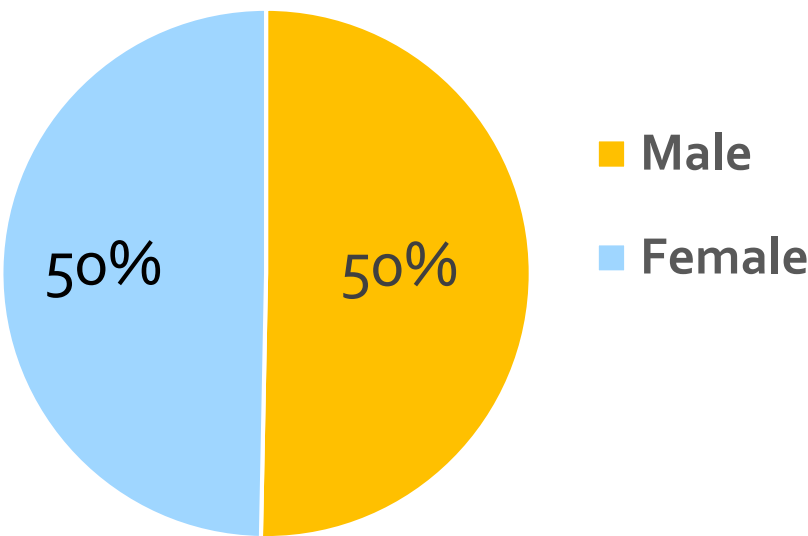


# Into the Numbers: 2019 Plano Homeless Population - All

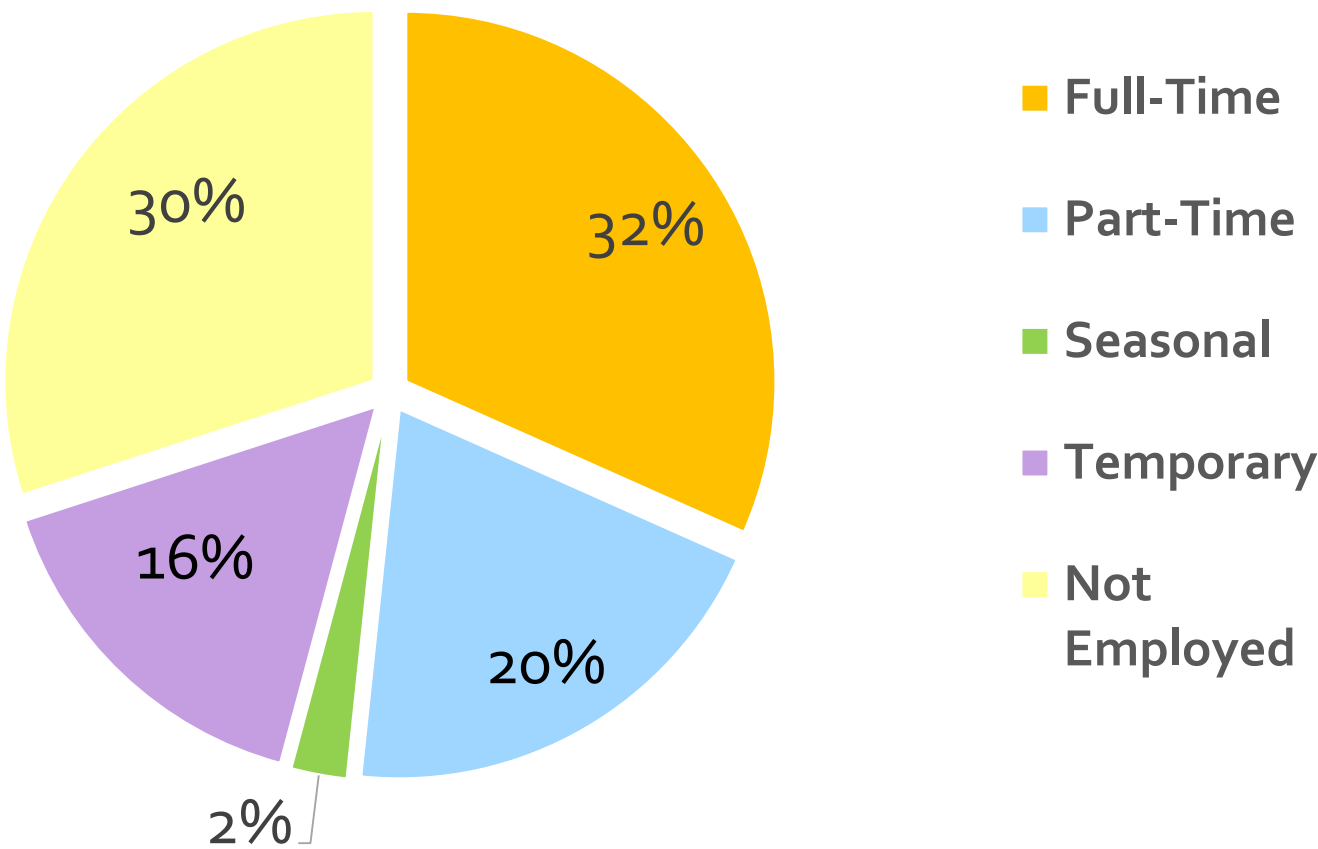
## ■ Top 5 Reported Needs

Gender



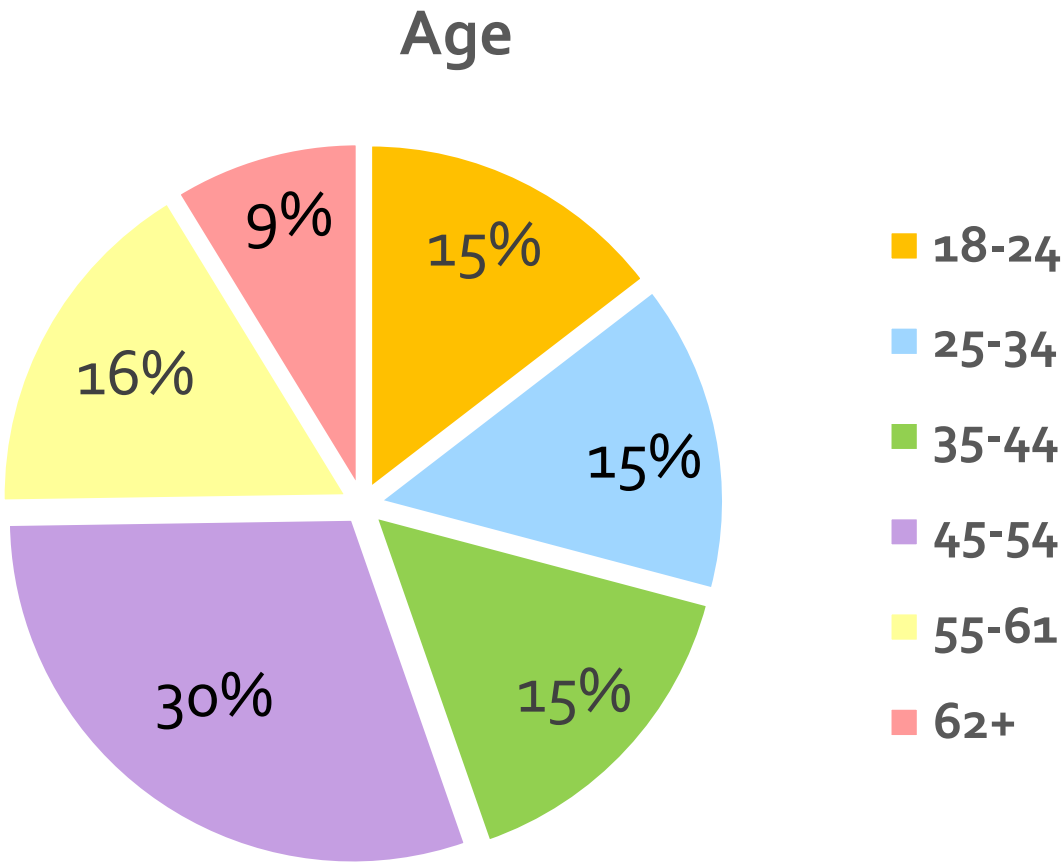
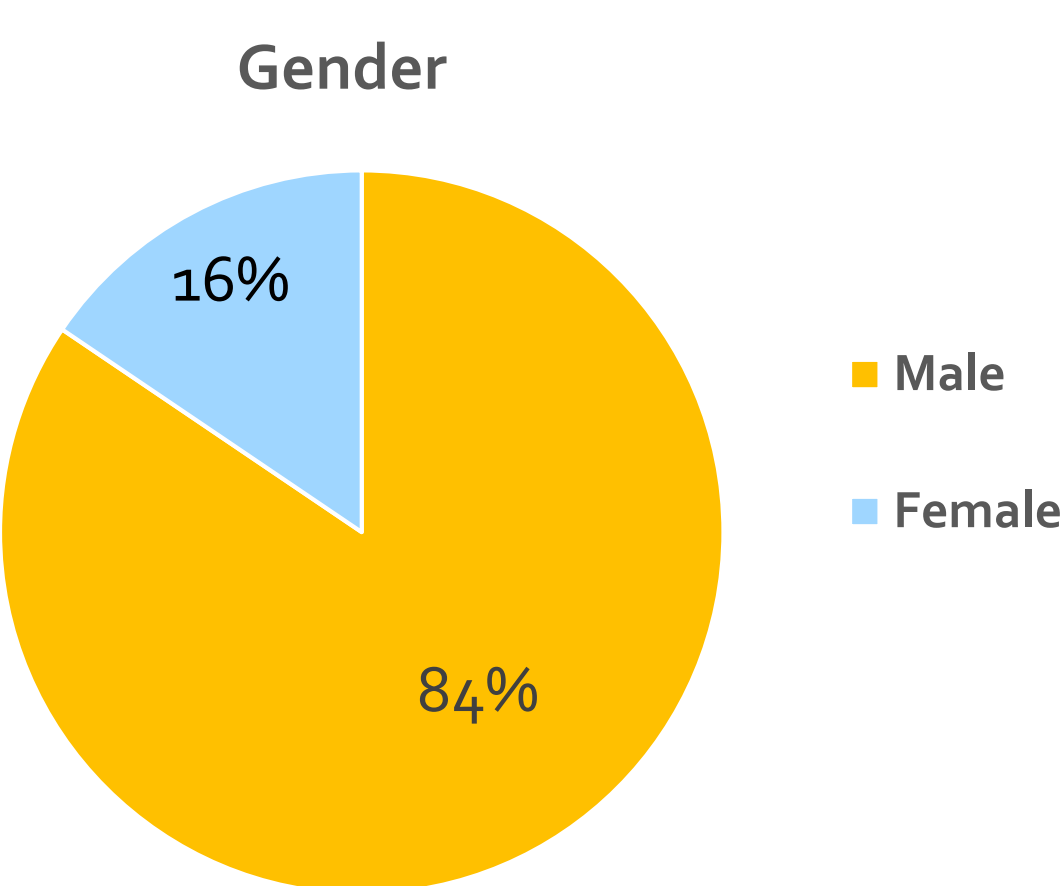
Employment Status



# Into the Numbers:

## 2019 Plano Homeless Population - Unsheltered

- 56 people stayed at POWS, remainder chose to stay outside or in their cars
- 5 unsheltered veterans
- 42% self-report having a disability



# Homeless Outreach Efforts: October 1, 2018 - September 30, 2019

- Street Outreach
  - Began October 2017 – Cross-departmental approach
- Harrington Library Assistance
  - 146 Individuals assisted one on one assistance
- Hospital Homeless Initiative
  - 9 individuals assisted
- On-call/Outside Assistance
  - 30 individuals assisted

# Homeless Services: Direct Assistance

## Direct Services

- Homeless Shelter Funding
  - \$586K - City general funds (BCSG) and federal funds (CDBG)
- Rapid Rehousing Program
  - \$137K – State funds (HHSP)
- Homelessness Prevention Program
  - \$497K – federal funds (CDBG)



# Homeless Services: County and Regional Collaboration

  - Established by the City of Plano in 2005
- Metro Dallas Homeless Alliance
  - Homeless Census Coordination and City Board Leadership
- Continuum of Care
