Subject: Consideration of 2026 City Council Meeting Dates

Please find attached a draft of the proposed 2026 City Council Meeting calendar for your review and consideration. In developing this schedule, we have carefully compared proposed meeting dates against key cultural and religious observances, city holidays, the Plano ISD calendar, and major conferences relevant to city leadership. Based on these considerations, a few minor adjustments are recommended.

The following observances were reviewed as part of the scheduling process:

• - Chinese New Year: Tuesday, February 17

Ramadan Begins: Tuesday, February 17

- Passover: Begins at sundown, Wednesday, April 1

- Easter: Sunday, April 5

Eid al-Fitr (end of Ramadan): Thursday, March 19

- Vesak Day: Friday, May 1

- Eid al-Adha: Begins at sundown, Tuesday, May 26

• - Rosh Hashanah: Friday-Sunday, September 11–13

Yom Kippur: Sunday–Monday, September 20–21

Columbus Day/Indigenous Peoples' Day: Monday, October 12

- Diwali: Sunday–Thursday, November 8–12

- Hanukkah: Friday–Saturday, December 4–12

- Kwanzaa: Saturday, December 26 – Thursday, January 1
