

# Funding Levels 2007-2017








# TIF: What is it?

- Tax increment financing (TIF) is an economic development tool used to promote investment in a defined area.
- TIF #2 has historically been used to finance public improvements sponsored by the City and Private Developers in Downtown Plano.






# TIF: How do we use the funds?

- Help create a place where development wants to happen

- Overcome barriers that inhibit development
- Promote quality development
