Public Hearing and consideration of an Ordinance as requested in Zoning Case 2025-016 to amend the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City, Ordinance No. 2015-5-2, as heretofore amended, to amend Specific Use Permit No. 56 for a Commercial Antenna Support Structure on 0.1 acre of land located 225 feet north of Democracy Drive and 220 feet east of Partnership Road, in the City of Plano, Collin County, Texas, presently zoned Commercial Employment; directing a change accordingly in the official zoning map of the City; and providing a penalty clause, a repealer clause, a savings clause, a severability clause, a publication clause, and an effective date. Petitioner: Democracy Partners Ltd (Regular Item “2”)

City Staff advised the applicant requested the item be remanded back to the Planning and Zoning Commission. Mayor Muns opened the public hearing. No one requested to speak. Mayor Muns closed the public hearing.
